

Funeral of Mr. Hayes – the funeral of the late Mr. Jeremiah Hayes of this city, took place yesterday at St. Ann's Church. At 2 o'clock, the members of the St. Patrick's mutual benefit and protective society, of which the deceased was a member, met at the basement of the church and, after organizing under the direction of Mr. Peter Fahey, vice president, proceeded to the residence of the deceased on Park Street. The members of the society appeared with green sashes trained with silver lace and with Craig on the left arm. There were upwards of 300 present.

The remains were escorted by the procession to the church, the following gentlemen officiating as pallbearers: Alexander McAllister, John Lee, John Morrissey, Lawrence Dowd, Patrick Talty, Jacob Burkhardt. Father McDonald the usual solemn service for the dead. The remains were then escorted to the Catholic cemetery on the west side of the river. A large number of the friends and fellow citizens of the deceased were present to testify their respect for his memory.
