

## **FRANK N. TIERNEY.**

**LARCHMONT, N. Y., July 5—** Frank N. Tierney, of Tierney & Sleeper, representatives of millinery manufacturers, 392 Fifth Avenue, New York, died here this morning at his residence, the Brompton Apartments, after a long illness. He was born in New York sixty-six years ago.

Mr. Tierney was a member of the Larchmont Volunteer Fire Department for twenty-five years, and its chief in 1939-40. He belonged to the New York Millinery Men's Association and the Orienta Beach Club of Mamaroneck.
