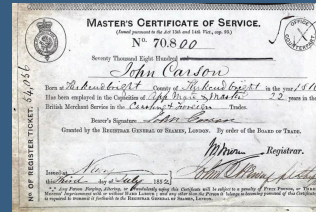


John Carson Issued Masters Certificate

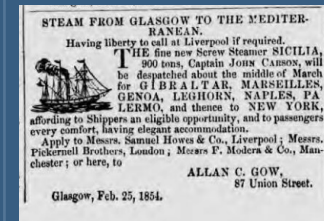

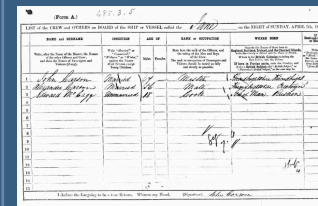

Marion Carson, Wife of John Carson, Ships Watchman in Birkenhead died secondary to a fall she had at 33 Nightly Street.

John Carson, Master of the Smack Eliza

Jan 15, 1848 – Apr 19, 1850

John is listed as a "Later master" of the Eliza, a ship formally owned by Robert Beattie. The master after John was Charles Belford (related to the Beatties)
